

CLUBHOUSE & DORM POLICY Kirra By-Laws

Below is an extract from the actual bylaws that are in effect at the Kirra SLSC. These shall form the basis of how we want our members to act, behave and respect the clubhouse while staying. Others are in affect but will only be enforced should they be required. This needs to be signed by all members and returned once for filing.

DORM:

1. Noise likely to interfere with sleeping members will not be tolerated.
2. No BOYS in female dorm and no GIRLS in male dorm. Strictly **NO FRATERNISATION** while on club premises, no exceptions.
3. U18 to be inside the club and checked in by 10.30pm.
4. Main lights in sleeping quarters must be off by 11.00pm.
5. All members shall vacate their bunks 1 hour before patrols are due to start and are required to carry out their duties and daily compulsory activities as per notice board and clubhouse officer's directions.
6. Dorms, common area, kitchen and toilets shall be swept and vacuumed, beds made, private clothing and belongings left in an orderly manner by 8am.
7. **NO SMOKING.** Smoking is strictly forbidden.
8. **NO DRUGS.** Any member found with drugs will be instantly suspended from the club and passed on to the relevant authorities.
9. **NO ALCOHOL.** Alcohol is not allowed in the dormitories or upstairs common area unless it is approved by the Management Committee.
10. **NO FOOD.** Food if stored in lockers must be in sealed containers. Food is not to be consumed in bunk rooms (dorms). All rubbish related to food shall be disposed of correctly.
11. All wet clothing is to be hung in the boatshed to dry. Towels are permitted to be hung on the end of your bed. At no time are clothes or towels to be hung on the windows or roof.

CLUBHOUSE:

1. The benefits of club privileges shall be permitted only to current financial members.
2. **ALL MEMBERS ARE TO SIGN IN UPON ARRIVAL.** U18 to bring permission slips.
3. Should you consume any of the club supplies for breakfast you are required to participate in some form of club activity. For example, setting up or packing up patrols, doing a patrol, fundraising, nipper water safety, carnival workforce or anything else asked of by the clubhouse officer.
4. Unseemly conduct likely to interfere or offend the comfort of other members shall not be tolerated and members are requested to assist in preventing such conduct.
5. At no time are patrol uniforms to be worn other than for patrols. **No exceptions.**
6. Damage occasioned to facilities shall be subject to investigation and decision of liability by the Membership Committee.
7. A roster of duties shall be placed next to the sign on log. On arrival you are to place your name against one of the tasks that you will be responsible for. First in best dressed.
8. Any refusal of clubhouse duties shall be dealt with by the clubhouse officer and club captain. You will be asked to leave and not permitted to return until you explain your actions.
9. Alcohol may only be consumed by those members over 18 years downstairs or at an organised function arranged by the committee. Please drink responsibly.

I understand my obligations to the Kirra SLSC and accept that I will abide by the directions given within this policy. U18 must be signed by both a parent/guardian and the member.
